In this session, we invite school and system leaders to:


• **explore** EEF's findings of how a sustainable model of partnership-based peer review can be used to support a diverse range of school improvement and leadership development priorities;

Appropriate Body Service

On 15 November 2022, the Department for Education published a <u>response to the</u> <u>consultation</u> on Appropriate Body reform and induction assessment, held from 26 May to 21 July 2022. We appreciate that these changes will impact schools and to support the transition, the DfE has prepared an <u>information pack</u>.

The attached pack is to help Appropriate Bodies (ABs) provide schools with the information they need about what is changing with local AB services, and any choices school leaders and Induction Tutors may need to make about how they access Appropriate Body (AB) services in the future to support the induction of Early Career Teacher (ECTs).

As Teaching School Hubs (TSHs) are now the designated organisation for this service from September 2024, we are delighted to inform you that we will be providing this service as your local TSH. If you require any further information related to this then please get in touch.




